**SENATE AMENDMENT ,  
TO SENATE BILL 11**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 60, line 16: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 153g.** 66.1105 (2) (k) of the statutes is renumbered 66.1105 (2) (k) 1.  
4 and amended to read:

5 66.1105 (2) (k) 1. “Tax incremental district” means a contiguous geographic  
6 area within a city defined and created by resolution of the local legislative body,  
7 consisting solely of whole units of property as are assessed for general property tax  
8 purposes, other than railroad rights-of-way, rivers or highways. Railroad  
9 rights-of-way, rivers or highways may be included in a tax incremental district only  
10 if they are continuously bounded on either side, or on both sides, by whole units of  
11 property as are assessed for general property tax purposes which are in the tax  
12 incremental district. “Tax incremental district” does not include any area identified  
13 as a wetland on a map under s. 23.32, except for an area identified on such a map that

1 has been converted in compliance with state law so that it is no longer a wetland and  
2 except as provided in subd. 2.

3 **SECTION 153m.** 66.1105 (2) (k) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

4 66.1105 (2) (k) 2. For an area that is identified as a wetland on a map under  
5 s. 23.32 and that is within the boundaries of a tax incremental district or is part of  
6 a tax incremental district parcel, the area shall be considered part of the tax  
7 incremental district for determining the applicability of exemptions from or  
8 compliance with water quality standards that are applicable to wetlands.”
