1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 138, line 7: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011-12 by
3 \$35,800,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012-13 by \$35,800,700
4 to increase funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.

5 **2.** Page 218, line 3: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012-13 by
6 \$12,000,000 to increase funding for the transitional jobs program.

7 **3.** Page 237, line 4: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011-12 by
8 \$60,390 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012-13 by \$38,610 for the
9 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

10 **4.** Page 299, line 13: delete that line and substitute:

1 assistance available under this section, which may include assistance in receiving
2 medical care, dental care, education, employment, single room occupancy housing,
3 and transitional housing. The department may provide payments to facilitate the
4 provision of services under this section. From the appropriation under s. 20.485 (2)
5 (ac), the department shall provide \$15,000 annually during fiscal years 2007-08 and
6 2008-09 to the Center for Veterans Issues, Ltd., of Milwaukee, to provide outreach

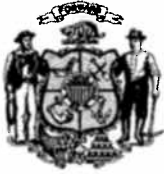
