Hi Cathlene and Rick.

I have some additional amendment request for ASA 1 to AB 40. As before, they should be drafted in Rep. Barca's name and sent to his office. Again, if possible, however, I would like to get the LRB drafting numbers for each of these requests (when available) so that I help to identify amendments as they come into the Barca office.

#### Here is the new list:

- 1. Repeal provisions of Act 10 related to collective bargaining.
- 2. Keep Ethan Allen and Southern Oaks Girls School open as juvenile corrections facilities.
- 3. Retain current law and funding with regard to Youth Aids.
- 4. Retain current law with regard to vesting in the Wisconsin Retirement System.
- 5. Retain current law and funding with regard to the Focus on Energy program.
- Return to classified status all unclassified positions that were classified on January 1, 2011, and eliminate all unclassified positions that did not exist prior to January 1, 2011.
- 7. Retain current law with regard to information technology managers and the executive salary group.
- 8. Retain current law and funding with regard the Office of Energy Independence.
- 9. Retain current law with regard to state fuel use policies.
- 10. Eliminate Office of Business Development at the Department of Administration.
- 11. Retain current law and funding with regard to Youth Diversion Grants and related law enforcement funding.
- 12. Retain current law with regard to Court-Appointed Special Advocates.
- 13. Eliminate study of the feasibility of instituting a program for private construction of buildings for the purpose of leasing those building to the state.
- 14. Retain current law with regard to the functions of the State Treasurer.
- 15. Retain current law with regard to the functions of the Secretary of State.
- 16. Retain current law with regard to the functions of the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority.
- 17. Retain current law and funding with regard to District Attorney Information Technology.
- 18. Eliminate small claims court modifications.
- 19. Provide funding requested by the Department of Employee Trust Funds for increased retirements by state workers.
- 20. Eliminate study of potential modifications to the Wisconsin Retirement System.
- 21. Amend current law to require GAB to post statements of economic interest online and require GAB to develop software to better track those who are viewing statements online.

- 22. Convert the biennial lapse requirement under the Office of the Governor to a biennial budget reduction of \$582,200.
- 23. Require a programmatic audit of the Department of Safety and Professional Services by December 2012.
- 24. Eliminate the provision to authorize the Department of Veterans Affairs to enter into an agreement with a private entity to operate the Veterans Home at Chippewa Falls and perform such management and care using personnel employed by the private entity. In addition, eliminate the audit related to this provision.

Here is the list:

- 25. Retain current law and funding with regard to the Democracy Trust Fund (a.k.a. Impartial Justice).
- 26. Retain current law and funding with regard to the Wisconsin Election Campaign Fund.
- 27. Amend current law to require GAB to post statements of economic interest online.
- 28. Delete all provisions added under Motion #430 (Surety Bond Compensation and Licensing Fees).
- 29. Delete all provisions added under Item 1 of Motion #472 (Provisions Affecting Local Law Enforcement and Firefighting Employers and Employees).
- 30. Retain current law with regard to payment of a police officer's salary after discharge in a first class city.
- 31. Retain current law with regard to maintenance of effort for emergency services.
- 32. Retain current law and funding with regard to indigent civil legal services.
- 33. Rescind the provisions of 2011 Act 10 which would eliminate collective bargaining rights for the Wisconsin State Public Defender Association, the Association of State Prosecutors, and the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association.
- 34. Create a continuing Gifts and Grants PR appropriation for the Judicial Council to supplement funding provided through transfers from the Supreme Court.
- 35. Amend the definition of "manufacturer" under §139.30(7) to include the owners of machines that use electricity to roll cigarettes ("Roll Your Own" machines).
