ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 39, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 40

June 14, 2011 – Offered by Representatives Roys, Young, Seidel, Sinicki, Berceau, Bewley, Hebl, Pope-Roberts, Zamarripa, Clark, Mason, Pasch, Hulsey and Vruwink.

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

13.086 Bills affecting individual taxes. No house of the legislature may pass a bill that affects the taxes paid by any individual unless the bill is referred to the department of revenue and the department of revenue certifies that the bill will not increase the amount of taxes that would be paid by any individual over the amount that the individual would be required to pay under current law.

71.01 **(1n)** For purposes of s. 71.04 (7) (df), and (dh), (dj), and (dk), "domicile" means an individual's true, fixed, and permanent home where the individual intends to remain permanently and indefinitely and to which, whenever absent, the
