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**SENATE AMENDMENT 3,
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 40**

June 16, 2011 – Offered by Senators ERPENBACH, CARPENTER, WIRCH, C. LARSON, LASSA, MILLER, HOLPERIN, HANSEN, S. COGGS, JAUCH, RISSER, TAYLOR, VINEHOUT and T. CULLEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 199, line 6: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011–12 by
4 \$638,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012–13 by \$638,700 for the
5 purposes for which the appropriation is made.

6 **2.** Page 199, line 21: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011–12 by
7 \$42,500 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012–13 by \$42,500 for the
8 purposes for which the appropriation is made.

9 **3.** Page 200, line 12: delete “Women’s health block grant” and substitute
10 “Family planning”.

11 **4.** Page 200, line 12: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011–12 by
12 \$193,600 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012–13 by \$193,600 for the
13 purpose of providing family planning services under s. 253.07.

1 **5.** Page 218, line 4: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011–12 by
2 \$800,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012–13 by \$3,600,000 to
3 increase funding for child care subsidies.

4 **6.** Page 218, line 4: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012–13 by
5 \$12,000,000 to increase funding for the transitional jobs demonstration project.

6 **7.** Page 339, line 11: delete lines 11 to 18.

7 **8.** Page 342, line 3: after that line insert:

8 “**SECTION 642d.** 20.435 (4) (bv) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 20.435 **(4)** (bv) *Prescription drug assistance for elderly; aids.* Biennially, the
10 amounts in the schedule for payment to pharmacies and pharmacists under s. 49.688
11 (7) for prescription drug assistance for elderly persons and, if there are moneys
12 remaining after payments to pharmacies and pharmacists, for the purposes under
13 s. 49.688 (13).”.

17 All moneys received from rebate payments by manufacturers under s. 49.688 (6), to
18 be used for payment to pharmacies and pharmacists under s. 49.688 (7) for
19 prescription drug assistance for elderly persons and, if there are moneys remaining
20 after payments to pharmacies and pharmacists, for the purposes under s. 49.688
21 (13).

22 **SECTION 646k.** 20.435 (4) (jb) of the statutes is amended to read:

23 20.435 **(4)** (jb) *Prescription drug assistance for elderly; enrollment fees.* All
24 moneys received from payment of enrollment fees under s. 49.688 (3), to be used for

1 administration of the program under s. 49.688 and, if there are moneys remaining
2 after paying for program administration, for the purposes under s. 49.688 (13).”.
