Beth,

The language from JFC regarding the passive review of MA changes will supersede the language from Act 10 (which required rules). The JFC language allows DHS to make policies that conflict with statutes, as long as they submit them to JFC under passive review, and to make other policies that don't conflict with statutes.

As I understand from the other requests on your list regarding the MA language that was originally in Act 10, I will require any changes to Badgercare to go through the legislature and will prohibit DHS from making changes that conflict with (or supersede) statutes. I will require that the waiver under new s. 49.45 (2m) (e) 2. (re: MOE) will also go through joint finance and will change the date such that income levels couldn't be reduced before Dec. 31, 2013.

Obtaining a waiver is already required and the Act 10 language is already superseded by the language in the substitute amendment, so I believe that those are the changes to MA the I am making for you in the health care package. Please let me know if this is incomplete or incorrect.

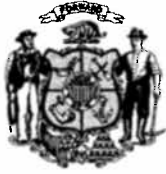

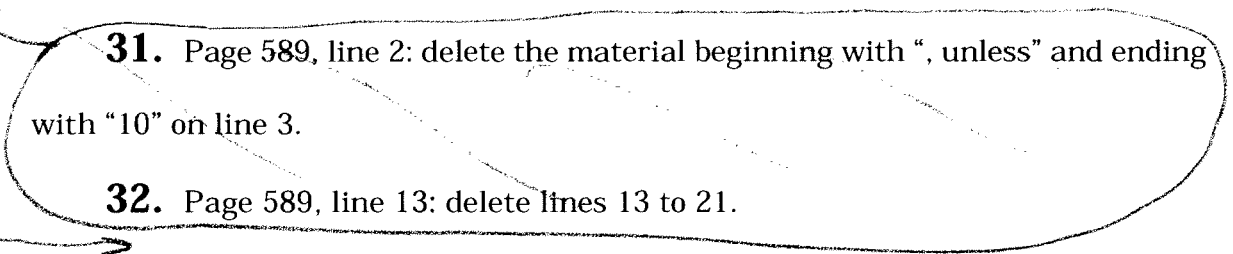
