TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1
SENATE

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 17, line 9: after that line insert:

3 “(8m) Subsections (4), (5), and (6) do not apply in an action where there is a
4 finding that damages were caused by an act or omission by an employee of a
5 long-term care provider that constitutes an offense against an elderly or vulnerable
6 person, as defined in s. 939.22 (20d), and that the long-term care provider’s
7 negligence was a proximate cause of the employee’s act or omission.”.
