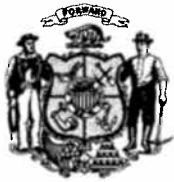

5 (1) CIRCUIT COURT BRANCHES, 2012. The initial election for circuit judge for branch
6 2 of the circuit court for Calumet County, branch 2 of the circuit court for Adams
7 County, branch 2 of the circuit court for Waushara County, branch 4 of the circuit
8 court for Wood county, branch 2 of the circuit court for Jackson County, branch 2 of
9 the circuit court for Langlade County, branch 6 of the circuit court for Marathon
10 County, branch 2 of the circuit court for Vilas county, branch 3 of the circuit court for
11 Polk County, and branch 2 of the circuit court for Sawyer County shall be at the
