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

Hi Joe –

Rep. Mason would like three separate amendments drafted to AB 4.

1. Specifying that the additional \$25 million of credits allocation could only go towards the creation of new, full-time jobs that pay at least 150% of the federal minimum wage and that comply with the health care requirements included in the existing law economic development tax credit laws.
2. Specifying that the additional \$25 million of credits allocation could only go towards employee training for either existing employees or new hires at any of Wisconsin's technical colleges. The training could be in credit or degree courses, basic skills, state or federally mandated programs, or other areas that directly enhance an employer's competitiveness and/or help the employer obtain a skilled workforce to meet its particular needs.
3. Requiring a report back to the legislature (via Joint Finance is fine) every six months about how many new jobs have been created as a result of allocation of any of the economic development tax credits.

Let's talk tomorrow morning to discuss these in more detail. Thanks, Joe! Hope you're holding up ok in the flurry of new session activity!

TO ASSEMBLY BILL 4

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill[✓] as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 7:[✓] after that line insert:

3 “ⁿ(2) JOB CREATION LIMITATION. Notwithstanding section 560.702[✓] of the statutes,
4 the department of commerce shall certify a person as eligible under section 560.701
5 (2)[✓] for a portion of the additional tax credits authorized by ^{CS}section 1 of this act only
6 on the basis of a project that creates new full-time jobs that pay at least 150 percent
7 of the federal minimum wage[✓] and that comply with applicable rules promulgated by
8 the department of commerce under section 560.706 (2) (a) of the statutes.”[✓]
