ASSEMBLY BILL 5

1 AN ACT *to create* 13.085 of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring a supermajority

for passage of tax increase legislation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.085 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **13.085 Bills increasing certain tax rates. (1)** Except as provided in sub.

5 (2), no house of the legislature may pass a bill that increases the rate of the state sales

6 tax or that increases any of the rates of the income tax or franchise tax unless the bill

- 7 is approved by two-thirds of those members present and voting.
- 8 (2) Subsection (1) shall not apply if the legislature passes a joint resolution
 9 requiring a statewide advisory referendum on the question of whether the

- 1 legislature should authorize the tax increase provided in the bill and a majority of
- 2 voters voting at the referendum vote to approve the tax increase.
