4 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
5 administration are increased by 1.0 GPR economist position, to be funded from the
6 appropriation under section 20.505 (1) (a) of the statutes, for the purpose of
7 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
8 affected by this act.

9 SECTION 9103. Nonstatutory provisions; Agriculture, Trade and
10 Consumer Protection.

11 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
12 agriculture, trade and consumer protection are increased by 1.0 GPR economist

1 position, to be funded from the appropriation under section 20.115 (8) (a) of the
2 statutes, for the purpose of preparing economic impact analyses under section
3 227.137 of the statutes, as affected by this act.

4 **SECTION 9108. Nonstatutory provisions; Children and Families.**

20 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
21 affected by this act.

22 **SECTION 9115. Nonstatutory provisions; Employee Trust Funds.**

23 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
24 employee trust funds are increased by 1.0 SEG economist position, to be funded from
25 the appropriation under section 20.515 (1) (w) of the statutes, for the purpose of

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1 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
2 affected by this act.

3 **SECTION 9117. Nonstatutory provisions; Financial Institutions.**

4 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
5 financial institutions are increased by 1.0 PR economist position, to be funded from
6 the appropriation under section 20.144 (1) (g) of the statutes, for the purpose of
7 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
8 affected by this act.

9 **SECTION 9121. Nonstatutory provisions; Health Services.**

19 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
20 affected by this act.

21 **SECTION 9136. Nonstatutory provisions; Public Defender Board.**

22 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the public defender
23 board are increased by 1.0 GPR economist position, to be funded from the
24 appropriation under section 20.550 (1) (a) of the statutes, for the purpose of

1 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
2 affected by this act.

7 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
8 affected by this act.

9 **SECTION 9139. Nonstatutory provisions; Public Service Commission.**

10 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the public service
11 commission are increased by 1.0 PR economist position, to be funded from the
12 appropriation under section 20.155 (1) (g) of the statutes, for the purpose of
13 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
14 affected by this act.

15 **SECTION 9140. Nonstatutory provisions; Regulation and Licensing.**

16 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
17 regulation and licensing are increased by 1.0 PR economist position, to be funded
18 from the appropriation under section 20.165 (1) (g) of the statutes, for the purpose
19 of preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
20 affected by this act.

21 **SECTION 9141. Nonstatutory provisions; Revenue.**

22 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
23 revenue are increased by 1.0 GPR economist position, to be funded from the
24 appropriation under section 20.566 (3) (a) of the statutes, for the purpose of

1 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
2 affected by this act.

3 **SECTION 9143. Nonstatutory provisions; State Employment Relations,**
4 **Office of.** *employment*

5 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the office of state
6 *employee* relations are increased by 1.0 PR economist position, to be funded from the
7 appropriation under section 20.545 (1) (k) of the statutes, for the purpose of
8 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
9 affected by this act. *board*

10 **SECTION 9146. Nonstatutory provisions; Technical College System.**

11 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the technical college
12 *system* are increased by 1.0 GPR economist position, to be funded from the
13 appropriation under section 20.292 (1) (a) of the statutes, for the purpose of
14 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
15 affected by this act.

16 **SECTION 9148. Nonstatutory provisions; Transportation.**

17 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
18 transportation are increased by 1.0 SEG economist position, to be funded from the
19 appropriation under section 20.395 (4) (aq) of the statutes, for the purpose of
20 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
21 affected by this act.

22 **SECTION 9151. Nonstatutory provisions; University of Wisconsin**
23 **Hospitals and Clinics Board.**

24 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the University of
25 Wisconsin hospitals and clinics board are increased by 1.0 PR economist position, to

1 be funded from the appropriation under section 20.495 (1) (g) of the statutes, for the
2 purpose of preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the
3 statutes, as affected by this act.

4 **SECTION 9152. Nonstatutory provisions; University of Wisconsin**
5 **System.** board of regents of the

6 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the University of
7 Wisconsin system are increased by 1.0 GPR economist position, to be funded from the
8 appropriation under section 20.285 (3) (a) of the statutes, for the purpose of
9 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
10 affected by this act.

11 **SECTION 9153. Nonstatutory provisions; Veterans Affairs.**

12 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
13 veterans affairs are increased by 1.0 PR economist position, to be funded from the
14 appropriation under section 20.485 (1) (gk) of the statutes, for the purpose of
15 preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
16 affected by this act.

17 **SECTION 9154. Nonstatutory provisions; Workforce Development.**

18 (1) ECONOMIST POSITION. The authorized FTE positions for the department of
19 workforce development are increased by 1.0 GPR economist position, to be funded
20 from the appropriation under section 20.445 (31) (a) of the statutes, for the purpose
21 of preparing economic impact analyses under section 227.137 of the statutes, as
22 affected by this act.”
