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

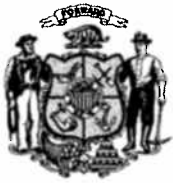

"SECTION 6g. 227.135 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

227.135 (5) The office of the governor shall maintain a record of each individual, other than an elected official or an employee of the state, who met with the governor or with a member of the governor's staff concerning a statement of the scope of a proposed rule. That record shall include the name of the individual, the name of any organization represented by the individual, a statement as to whether the individual or organization supports or opposes the proposed rule, and a statement as to whether the individual or organization requested any modifications to the statement of scope. The office of the governor shall make those records

1 available for public inspection and copying and shall post those records on that
2 office's Internet site." ✓

4 3. Page 16, line ~~2~~⁹: after that line insert:

5 "(2) The office of the governor shall maintain a record of each individual, other

7 a member of the governor's staff concerning the governor's approval or rejection of
8 a proposed rule. That record shall include the name of the individual, the name of
9 any organization represented by the individual, a statement as to whether the
10 individual or organization supports or opposes the proposed rule, and a statement
11 as to whether the individual or organization requested any modifications to the
12 proposed rule. The office of the governor shall make those records available for public
13 inspection and copying and shall post those records on that office's Internet site." ✓

15 make available for public inspection and copying, and post on the office's Internet site
16 records concerning the statement of the scope of a proposed emergency rule in the
17 manner required under s. 227.135 (5)." ✓

18 5. Page ~~14~~²⁷, line ~~14~~²: after "writing." insert "The office of the governor shall
19 maintain, make available for public inspection and copying, and post on the office's
20 Internet site records concerning the governor's approval or rejection of a proposed
21 emergency rule in the manner required under s. 227.185 (2)." ✓
