143r SECTION (240r) 814.61 (10) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

814.61 (10) (c) The clerk may not collect a fee for a copy of a court order if the requester provides the clerk with an affidavit of indigency and a statement, in writing, that the requested court order is being obtained for the purpose of obtaining an operator's license issued under ch. 343 or an identification card issued under s. 343.50 for purposes of voting.".

Representative Mason,

Please review this amendment to ensure that it is consistent with your intent. Please note that this amendment requires a person to submit an affidavit of indigency. The amendment does not define indigency, and the term is not generally defined in the statutes. Several statutes refer, instead, to the federal poverty line and require a person's gross income to be at or below the poverty line or a certain percent of the poverty line.

See, for example, s. 46.297 (2) (b), which states that a hearing impaired person may be eligible to receive assistance for telecommunication aids if the "adjusted gross income of the person's family is equal to or less than 200% of the poverty line established under 42 USC 9902 (2)." Other statutes use different percents, so if you would like to take that approach to determine what constitutes indigency, we should discuss the exact figures you would like to use.
