**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 148**

June 8, 2011 – Offered by Representative Vos.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 11: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 1p.** 2011 Wisconsin Act 10, section 9208 (1) is repealed.”.

4 **2.** Page 3, line 1: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 2p.** 2011 Wisconsin Act 10, section 9221 (1) is repealed.”.

6 **3.** Page 3, line 6: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 9208. Fiscal changes; Children and Families.**

8 (1) INCOME AUGMENTATION LAPSE.

9 (a) Notwithstanding section 20.001 (3) (c) of the statutes, there is lapsed to the  
10 general fund from the appropriation account to the department of children and  
11 families under section 20.437 (1) (kx) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011,  
12 \$2,011,200 in the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection  
13 takes effect.

1 (b) Notwithstanding 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9201 (1c) (a), the secretary  
2 of administration shall apply the lapse under paragraph (a) to the lapse requirement  
3 for the 2009–11 fiscal biennium under 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9201 (1c) (a).”.

4 **4.** Page 4, line 3: after that line insert:

5 “(4) INCOME AUGMENTATION LAPSE.

6 (a) Notwithstanding section 20.001 (3) (c) of the statutes, there is lapsed to the  
7 general fund from the appropriation account to the department of health services  
8 under section 20.435 (8) (mb) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2011,  
9 \$4,500,000 in the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection  
10 takes effect.

11 (b) Notwithstanding 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9201 (1c) (a), the secretary  
12 of administration shall apply the lapse under paragraph (a) to the lapse requirement  
13 for the 2009–11 fiscal biennium under 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9201 (1c) (a).”.
