10	SECTION 1p. 20.505 (4) (da) of the statutes is created to read:

- **2.** Page 2, line 1: delete "Section 1" and substitute "Section 1v".
 - **3.** Page 3, line 6: after that line insert:

"Section 9101. Nonstatutory provisions; Administration.

(1) Extraordinary police services provided to state facilities. Before expenditure of any moneys appropriated under section 20.505 (4) (da) of the statutes, as created by this act, the secretary of administration shall report to the cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance the specific items proposed to be expended. The report shall specifically include expenditures to reimburse local governments for police services provided to state facilities. No moneys may be expended from that appropriation until the proposed expenditure is approved by the committee.".
