1 **AN ACT** *to repeal* 16.964 (16), 20.505 (6) (kq) and (kr), 165.85 (4) (b) 1d. f. and
2 349.027; and *to amend* 20.505 (6) (kp) of the statutes; **relating to:** collection
3 and analysis of motor vehicle traffic stop information and law enforcement
4 training standards.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 16.964 (16) of the statutes is repealed.

6 **SECTION 2.** 20.505 (6) (kp) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 20.505 **(6)** (kp) *Data gathering and analysis.* The amounts in the schedule for
8 gathering and analyzing statistics on the justice system, including racial disparity,
9 uniform crime reporting, and incident-based reporting. Of each \$21.50 received
10 under s. 814.86 (1), \$1.50 shall be credited to this appropriation account ~~and the~~

3 **SECTION 3.** 20.505 (6) (kq) and (kr) of the statutes are repealed.

4 **SECTION 4.** 165.85 (4) (b) 1d. f. of the statutes is repealed.

5 **SECTION 5.** 349.027 of the statutes is repealed.

6 **SECTION 6. Nonstatutory provisions.**

7 (1) Any system development commenced under authority of 2009 Wisconsin
8 Act 28, section 9101 (12x), prior to the effective date of this subsection shall
9 terminate on the effective date of this subsection.
