



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 15**

May 17, 2011 – Offered by Representatives CLARK and BARCA.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 16.964 (16) (b) (intro.), 349.027 (1) and 349.027 (2) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** collection and analysis of motor vehicle traffic stop
3 information.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 16.964 (16) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 16.964 **(16)** (b) (intro.) The office shall promulgate rules, for law enforcement
6 agencies electing to collect traffic stop information as provided in s. 349.027 (1),
7 relating to all of the following:

8 **SECTION 2.** 349.027 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
9 349.027 **(1)** INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUIRED. For each motor vehicle stop
10 made on or after January 1, 2011, by a law enforcement officer, the person in charge
11 of the law enforcement agency employing the law enforcement officer ~~shall~~ may

1 cause to be obtained all information relating to the traffic stop that is required to be
2 collected under specified in rules promulgated under s. 16.964 (16) (b) 1. The person
3 in charge of the law enforcement agency has the authority and discretion to
4 determine whether the agency will collect traffic stop information under this
5 subsection.

6 **SECTION 3.** 349.027 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 349.027 (2) SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION COLLECTED. ~~The~~ If a law enforcement
8 agency collects traffic stop information as provided in sub. (1), the person in charge
9 of a ~~the~~ law enforcement agency shall submit the information collected under sub.
10 (1) to the office of justice assistance using the process, and in the format, prescribed
11 by the rules promulgated under s. 16.964 (16) (b) 2.
