**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 93**

June 21, 2011 – Offered by Representatives BARCA, PASCH, SEIDEL, ROYS, MASON,
TURNER, YOUNG and E. COGGS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2 amendment 2, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 59, line 24: after that line insert:

4 “(3) If this amendment LRBa1363/1 is adopted, the Legislative Reference
5 Bureau shall in enrolling 2011 Wisconsin Act ... (Senate Bill 93) treat the provisions
6 of 2011 Wisconsin Act ... (Assembly Bill 40) that would have been affected by the
7 following amendments to Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 40:
8 AA4, AA5, AA6, AA8, AA9, AA13, AA35, and AA39 and LRBb1326/1, as they relate
9 to payday loan changes, junk mail sales tax exemption, Marinette County, the Space
10 Station, position authorizations above base, the earned income tax credit, the
11 homestead tax, combined reporting, the domestic production tax credit, capital gains
12 exemptions, funding for technical colleges, the transitional jobs program, the
13 Veterans Assistance Jobs Program, the Rural Economic Development Program, the

1 \$466 million cuts in health care services and benefits, BadgerCare Plus, process for
2 Medicaid changes, waivers to continue SeniorCare, WiSys Tech funding, tuition
3 increases and financial aid increases, the waiting period for unemployment benefits,
4 child labor laws, the ability of the secretary of health services to change nonstatutory
5 provisions of BadgerCare, BadgerCare Plus, Family Care, and SeniorCare, child
6 support enforcement funding, Wisconsin Works, and collective bargaining for public
7 sector employees, as those provisions would have appeared if those amendments had
8 been adopted as part of 2011 Wisconsin Act (Assembly Bill 40).”.
