department of veterans affairs; creation. There is created a department of veterans affairs under the direction and supervision of the board of veterans affairs. The board shall consist of 7 9 members who all of whom shall be veterans, including at least 2 who shall be Vietnam war veterans. The members shall be appointed for staggered 6—year 3—year terms. The board shall be composed so that for each congressional district in the state there is at least one member of the board who is a resident of that district. If a member ceases to reside within the boundaries of the congressional district where he or she resided as that district existed at the time that member's current term began, the member vacates his or her office.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

Notwithstanding section 15.49 of the statutes, as affected by this act, any person serving as a member of the board of veterans affairs on the effective date of this subsection whose nomination has been confirmed by the senate on or before that date may continue to hold office and exercise the powers and duties of that office for the residue of his or her unexpired 6-year term and until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.

(2) Notwithstanding section 17.20 (2) of the statutes, any person serving as a member of the board of veterans affairs on the effective date of this subsection whose nomination has not been confirmed by the senate on or before that date may continue to hold office and exercise the powers and duties of that office only until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.

(3) Until the membership of the board of veterans affairs comes into compliance with the residency requirements under section 15.49 of the statutes, as affected by this act, the governor, in making appointments under section 15.49 of the statutes,
