1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete lines 4 to 5 and substitute: "Affairs." *and*

3 **2.** Page 1, line 6: delete lines 6 to 11.

4 **3.** Page 2, line 2: delete lines 2 to 5 and substitute:

5 "15.49 (2) There is created a department of veterans affairs under the direction
6 and supervision of the board of veterans affairs. The board shall consist of 7 9
7 members".

8 **4.** Page 2, line 15: after that line insert:

9 "SECTION 4m. 15.49 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

10 15.49 (3) The secretary of veterans affairs shall be a veteran."

SECTION 1

1 **15.49 Department of veterans affairs; creation.** There is created a
 2 department of veterans affairs under the direction and supervision of the board of
 3 veterans affairs. The board shall consist of ~~7~~ ⁹ members ~~who~~ all of whom shall be
 4 veterans, ~~including at least 2 who shall be Vietnam war veterans.~~ The members
 5 shall be appointed for staggered 6-year 3-year terms. The board shall be composed
 6 so that for each congressional district in the state there is at least one member of the
 7 board who is a resident of that district. If a member ceases to reside within the
 8 boundaries of the congressional district where he or she resided as that district
 9 existed at the time that member's current term began, the member vacates his or her
 10 office.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

12 (1) ^m Notwithstanding section 15.49 ^v of the statutes, as affected by this act, any
 13 person serving as a member of the board of veterans affairs on the effective date of
 14 this subsection ^v whose nomination has been confirmed by the senate on or before that
 15 date may continue to hold office and exercise the powers and duties of that office for
 16 the residue of his or her unexpired 6-year term and until his or her successor is
 17 appointed and qualified.) ,

18 (2) Notwithstanding section 17.20 (2) of the statutes, any person serving as a
 19 member of the board of veterans affairs on the effective date of this subsection whose
 20 nomination has not been confirmed by the senate on or before that date may continue
 21 to hold office and exercise the powers and duties of that office only until his or her
 22 successor is appointed and qualified.

23 (3) Until the membership of the board of veterans affairs comes into compliance
 24 with the residency requirements under section 15.49 of the statutes, as affected by
 25 this act, the governor, in making appointments under section 15.49 of the statutes,

1 as affected by this act, shall ensure that the residency of the members of the board
2 adheres, to the maximum extent possible, to these residency requirements.

3 (1) (4) Notwithstanding the length of terms specified in section 15.49 of the
4 statutes, as affected by this act, the 2 additional members of the board of veterans
5 affairs to be appointed under section 15.49 of the statutes, as affected by this act,
6 shall serve for terms that expire as follows:

7 (a) One member shall serve for a term that expires on May 1, 2014.

8 (b) One member shall serve for a term that expires on May 1, 2015. 〃
