Subject: Time sensitive - amendment to SB 228

After hearing testimony at the public hearing today we would like to make the following changes/additions to our bill, SB 228 (Irb 1965). First, in 167.31(1)(g) add line #4 to address advances in muzzle loading technology. Second, in 167.31(4) add an exception for non-motorized vehicles. Third, in the bill draft itself on page 2 line 9, page 3 line 18, and page 4 line 4, add [or is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case.] This last change is to address a quirk in how crossbows are often handled.

We are hoping to have this amendment ready to be added to the committee notice going out tomorrow for an executive session on Wednesday. Please let me know if you have any questions or if there is anything we can do to ensure it is ready on time. Thank you.

167.31(1)(g) "Unloaded" means any of the following:

1. Having no shell or cartridge in the chamber of a firearm or in the magazine attached to a firearm.
2. In the case of a cap lock muzzle-loading firearm, having the cap removed.
3. In the case of a flint lock muzzle-loading firearm, having the flashpan cleaned of powder.
4. In the case of an electronic ignition muzzle-loading firearm, having the battery removed.

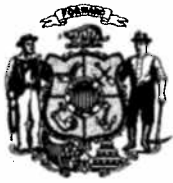

(4) Exceptions.

(i) Subsection (2) (b) and (c) does not apply to a person lawfully hunting from a stationary non-motorized vehicle which is not attached to any motorized vehicle.

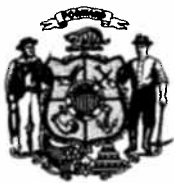
