## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill changes the statutory boundary between Green Lake County and Marquette County so that it matches what county and local officials understood the boundary to be. The bill also specifies that any actions, proceedings, transactions, conveyances, or other matters that occurred before the bill takes effect related to land affected by the boundary change shall be deemed to have occurred in the county where the property lies under the bill.

Since property has been assessed and property taxes have been levied in accordance with the boundary as local officials understood the boundary to be, the bill will have no effect on local taxes.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
