Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person who wishes to claim the film production services income and franchise tax credit must first submit an application to the Department of Tourism, along with an application fee equal to 2 percent of the person's production expenditures or \$5,000, whichever is less.

Under this bill, the application fee for the film production services credit is \$500.
