2011 WISCONSIN ACT 82

AN ACT *to amend* 973.01 (2) (c) 2. a.; and *to create* 939.635 of the statutes; **relating to:** crimes against children committed by certain persons and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 939.635 of the statutes is created to read:

939.635 Increased penalty for certain crimes against children committed by a child care provider.
If a person commits a violation of s. 948.02, 948.025, or 948.03 (2) or (3) against a child for whom the person was

providing child care for compensation, the maximum term of imprisonment for that crime may be increased by not more than 5 years.

SECTION 2. 973.01 (2) (c) 2. a. of the statutes is amended to read:

973.01 (2) (c) 2. a. Sections 939.621, 939.632, 939.635, 939.645, 946.42 (4), 961.46, and 961.49.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 2009–10: Effective date of acts. “Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor’s partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated” by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
