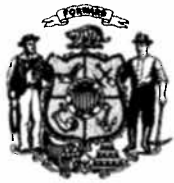

The amendment language is at the top of the memo. The rest of the memo helps explain why it's needed.

66.0104(2) No city, village, town, or county may enact an ordinance that places any of the following limitations on a residential landlord: (e) Additional requirements on security deposits or earnest money not found in Wis. Admin. Code Ch. ATCP 134. (f) Any pre or post tenancy inspection requirements of the premises not found in Wis. Admin. Code Ch. ATCP 134.

Current law: Landlords must provide a written notice to tenants on security deposit statements informing tenants of the tenants' right to request photographic evidence of the damages in their apartment. If this notice is not included on the statement, tenant shall be entitled to receive up to triple his/her actual damages plus reasonable attorney's fees and costs. Additionally, Madison General Ordinances require landlords to photograph any and all damages to deposits as long as they can be photographed. Failure to photograph damages that can be photographed prohibits withholding any amount from the deposit and again can result in owing triple damages.
