1 **AN ACT** *to affect* 2011 Wisconsin Act 32, section 9106 (1) (j) 1g. and 1r. of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** an addition to the 2011-13 Authorized State Building
3 Program.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill amends the 2011-13 Authorized State Building Program to add one project for the Department of Veterans Affairs. The project involves a renovation of Gates Hall at the Wisconsin Veterans Home at Union Grove. The project is financed with \$3,189,900 in federal funds and \$1,717,700 in existing program revenue supported borrowing authority.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
