Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-125 eliminates statutory language in order to clarify the scope of local government immunity for claims alleging injuries or damages caused by defects or want of repair of local highways.

The bill also eliminates a complicated secondary liability provision for such defects that only applies to local governments.

SB-125 retains the existing express immunity regarding natural accumulations of snow and ice on local highways for a period of 3 weeks following the snow or ice event.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This clarification by SB-125 tends to reduce local government liability exposure for highway defect claims and the local government cost of legal defense of those claims. This clarification may tend to reduce or stabilize local government insurance premiums.
