



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 291**

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 346.95 (1); and *to create* 346.89 (4) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** the use of a cellular or other wireless telephone by a probationary licensee
3 or instruction permittee while driving a motor vehicle and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 346.89 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
5 346.89 (4) Subject to sub. (3), no person who holds a probationary license issued
6 under s. 343.085, or an instruction permit issued under s. 343.07, may drive, as
7 defined in s. 343.305 (1) (b), any motor vehicle while using a cellular or other wireless
8 telephone, except to report an emergency.
