



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 7,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 311**

November 1, 2011 – Offered by Representative KAUFERT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 10: after “programs;” insert “Class D hunting permits issued to  
3 certain disabled persons;”.

4 **2.** Page 4, line 18: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 4m.** 29.053 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 29.053 (3) The department may modify any requirement of this chapter or  
7 rules promulgated under it, establish special seasons, authorize the use of special  
8 equipment or take any other action in order to provide additional hunting and fishing  
9 opportunities for persons who are physically disabled or visually handicapped and  
10 The department may limit the number of persons involved, except that if the  
11 department establishes a special season for hunting deer with firearms for persons

1 who are physically disabled, the season shall be open to persons who have been  
2 issued a Class D permit under s. 29.193 (2).”.

3 **3.** Page 5, line 19: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 5c.** 29.193 (2) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 29.193 **(2)** (b) 1. The department shall, after investigation and without  
6 charging a fee, except for the costs of review in par. (c) 3. or (e), issue a Class A, Class  
7 B ~~or~~, Class C, or Class D permit to any person, as provided in this subsection.

8 **SECTION 5e.** 29.193 (2) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

9 29.193 **(2)** (b) 3. As part of the application for a Class A ~~or~~, Class B, or Class D  
10 permit under this subsection, the applicant shall authorize the department by  
11 written release to examine all medical records regarding the applicant’s physical  
12 disability.

13 **SECTION 5g.** 29.193 (2) (c) 5. of the statutes is created to read:

14 29.193 **(2)** (c) 5. The department shall issue a Class D permit to any person with  
15 an amputation, or permanent substantial loss of function, of one or both arms or one  
16 or both hands.

17 **SECTION 5j.** 29.193 (2) (cr) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

18 29.193 **(2)** (cr) 4. A person holding a current resident or nonresident deer  
19 hunting license and a Class D permit may hunt deer of either sex with a firearm only  
20 during a special season established by the department that is open for hunting deer  
21 with firearms by disabled persons who hold a permit under this section.

22 **SECTION 5m.** 29.193 (2) (d) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

23 29.193 **(2)** (d) 3. A holder of a Class D permit may use an adaptive device, as  
24 authorized by the department by rule, to facilitate the use of a firearm and may be

1 accompanied by a person who is not eligible to apply for a permit under this section.  
2 The accompanying person may not hunt or carry a firearm, bow, or crossbow unless  
3 that person has been issued the appropriate approval to do so. The assistance  
4 rendered by an accompanying person who has not been issued the appropriate  
5 approval is limited to field dressing, tagging, and retrieving game for the permit  
6 holder and any other assistance authorized by the department by rule.”.
