At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page (), line () after "eventy" insert "regulating body gripping traps," seasons;

2. Page (7), line (4) after that line insert:

"Section 7m. 29.331 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

29.331 **(1m)** Body gripping traps. No person may set, place, or operate a body gripping trap of a type designed to kill an animal unless the trap is smaller than 36 square inches in size or unless at least one–half of the trap is submerged in water.".
