Technical memorandum on AB 290 - the manufacture of wine and

fermented malt beverages not offered for sale.

The Department of Revenue has the following concern regarding the bill:

Under the bill, individuals would not be required to hold a permit, or pay occupational taxes, to manufacture wine or fermented malt beverages for "educational purposes", or on-site tasting, if the beverage is not offered for sale. The bill does not include a definition for "educational purposes" and a broad interpretation of the phrase may not reflect the author's intent. The department recommends the bill be amended to define the term "educational purposes" to clarify the scope of the provision.
