



## 2011 SENATE BILL 402

January 26, 2012 - Introduced by Senator HARSDORF, cosponsored by Representatives RIPP, WYNN and SPANBAUER. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Environment.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 283.60 (1) (intro.) and (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** the  
2             waiver of requirements related to the discharge of water pollution for certain  
3             research projects.

### ***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) administers laws relating to the discharge of pollutants into surface water or groundwater, including the requirement to obtain a water pollution discharge permit before beginning a discharge. Current law authorizes DNR to waive the requirement to obtain a water pollution discharge permit for a research project to evaluate advanced agricultural nutrient management tools if certain requirements are met. This bill authorizes DNR to waive any requirement of the laws relating to the discharge of pollutants into the waters of the state for such a research project if the conditions are met.
