ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 2011 SENATE BILL 426

March 6, 2012 – Offered by Representatives Molepske Jr and Vruwink.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 3, line 6: delete "and (b)" and substitute ", (b) and (c)".
- **2.** Page 3, line 14: after that line insert:

"(c) If an individual is denied benefits under par. (a), the other members of the participant's Wisconsin Works group who are dependent children shall continue to receive the individual's benefits in the form of vendor payments, as defined by the department by rule, to a landlord or mortgagee of premises that are occupied by the dependent children. For purposes of this paragraph, the amount of the individual's benefits is the amount of benefits that the individual would have been eligible to receive if the individual had not committed an intentional program violation. The length of time that benefits may be provided under this paragraph is the length of time of the denial under par. (a) or the length of time for which the individual would

- 1 have received benefits if the individual had not committed an intentional violation,
- whichever is shorter.".
- **3.** Page 3, line 18: delete "3. and (b)" and substitute "3., (b), and (c)".
