1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 9, line 2: delete lines 2 and 3 and substitute "that provides an
3 instructional program in human growth and development shall annually provide
4 notify the parents or guardians of each pupil enrolled in the school district whether
5 or not the school board will provide an instructional program in human growth and
6 development in that school year. If the school board elects to provide an instructional
7 program under this section, the school board shall also provide the parents and
8 guardians".

9 2. Page 10, line 11: after that line insert:

10 "SECTION 33m. 118.019 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

11 118.019 (6) ANNUAL REPORT. Beginning in the 2012-13 school year, annually
12 by September 1, each school district shall submit a report to the department that
13 provides all of the following information:
