3 adult U.S. citizen. The absent elector, in the presence of the witness, shall mark the
4 ballot in a manner that will not disclose how the elector's vote is cast. The elector
5 shall then, still in the presence of the witness, fold the ballots so each is separate and
6 so that the elector conceals the markings thereon and deposit them in the proper
7 envelope. If a consolidated ballot under s. 5.655 is used, the elector shall fold the
8 ballot so that the elector conceals the markings thereon and deposit the ballot in the

5 which the elector has moved, any former qualified Wisconsin elector may vote an
6 absentee ballot in the ward of the elector's prior residence in any presidential election
7 occurring within 24 months after leaving Wisconsin by requesting an application
8 form and returning it, properly executed, to the municipal clerk of the elector's prior
9 Wisconsin residence. When requesting an application form for an absentee ballot,
10 the applicant shall specify the applicant's eligibility for only the presidential ballot.
11 Unless application is made under s. 6.86 (1) (ae), or the applicant is exempted from
12 providing proof of identification under s. 6.87 (4) (b) 2. or 3., or the applicant is a
