



**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 462**

March 9, 2012 – Offered by Senator GROTHMAN.

1     **AN ACT** *to repeal* 341.10 (6m) of the statutes; **relating to:** the registration of  
2     certain military vehicles by the Department of Transportation.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must refuse registration of a vehicle if, with an exception for former military vehicles eligible for a specific type of registration, the vehicle was manufactured for use in any country's military forces and does not meet federal motor vehicle safety standards.

This substitute amendment repeals this provision requiring DOT to refuse registration of a vehicle that was manufactured for use in any country's military forces and that does not meet federal motor vehicle safety standards.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3     **SECTION 1.** 341.10 (6m) of the statutes is repealed.

4     **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

5     (1) This act first applies to applications for registration received by the  
6     department of transportation on the effective date of this subsection.
