AN ACT to amend 29.164(2) (b), 29.173 (2) (a), 29.173 (2) (b) (intro.), 29.184 (3) (c), 29.193 (2) (cr) 1., 29.193 (2) (cr) 2. and 29.211 (2); and to create 29.014 (1m) of the statutes; relating to: regulation of weapons that may be used to hunt deer, bear, and wild turkey and requirements for establishing open deer hunting seasons.

Analysis

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) issues hunting licenses that authorize the hunting of specified animals such as deer, bear, turkey and small game. DNR also establishes seasons during which the hunting of certain animals with a specified weapon is allowed. Certain hunting licenses specify whether a firearm or bow and arrow may be used for hunting under those licenses. Current law also extends to certain disabled persons hunting privileges that are otherwise not granted under a particular hunting license including the authority to use a crossbow. Current law also allows a person who is at least 65 years old to hunt with a crossbow under the authority of an archery hunting license.

A resident or nonresident deer hunting license authorizes the holder of the license to only hunt with a firearm. A wild turkey hunting license or a Class A bear license authorizes the holder to hunt with a firearm or a bow and arrow, except that the holder of the respective license may also use a crossbow if the holder is at least 65 years old or is disabled and holds a permit that authorizes the use of a crossbow. This bill expands the allowable uses of a crossbow, except during the archery deer season, and the uses of a bow and arrow and a crossbow, by defining lesser and superior weapons and expanding the use of lesser weapons during stated firearms hunting seasons. Because of the very limited hunting allowed with airguns, they are not included in the definition of a lesser weapon, but are referred to only when allowed. The bill authorizes any person who is issued a resident or nonresident small game license, firearm deer hunting license, wild turkey hunting license, Class A bear license, or an elk hunting license to hunt with a weapon lesser to a firearm during the applicable open season regardless of the person's age or whether the person has a disability. The bill also authorizes a person who holds a resident or nonresident deer hunting license to hunt with a lesser weapon.

This bill also provides that, if DNR establishes an open season for hunting deer with a firearm, then the season must also be open for hunting deer with a lesser weapon. Under the bill, if DNR limits an open season to hunting deer with a bow and arrow and not with a firearm, then DNR shall not allow a person to hunt deer with a superior weapon (a firearm or crossbow)

during that open season unless the person has attained the age of 65 or holds a permit that authorizes the use of a crossbow.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

29. _____ of the statutes is created to read:

(a) Superior Weapons

For the purposes of this chapter, a weapon listed in either s. (c) (1) or (c) (2) is superior to a weapon listed in (c) (3), and; a weapon listed in (c) (1) is superior to a weapon listed in either (c) (2) or (c) (3).

(b) Lesser Weapons

For purposes of this chapter, a weapon listed in (c) (3) is lesser to a weapon listed in either (c) (1) or (c) (2), and; a weapon listed in (c) (2) is lesser to a weapon listed in (c) (1).

(c) Ranking of weapons

(1) A "firearm" includes any of the following:

"Rifle" as defined in s. 941.28 (1) (a)

"Shotgun" as defined in 941.28 (1) (d)

"Handgun" as defined in NR 10.09 (c)

"Muzzle-Loader" is defined in NR 10.001 (17) and (18)

(2) "Crossbow" means a device that discharges a bolt or quarrel ^{powered by a limb.} ~~consisting of a~~
~~bow mounted on a stock which, once drawn, is powered~~ ^{and held} solely by means
other than the effort of the person firing it.

(3) "Bow" means any device which propels an arrow, drawn and held by and through the effort of the person releasing it, but does not include a crossbow.

(d) Weapon, as used in this chapter means a firearm, crossbow, or bow.

SECTION 2. 29.014 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

29.014 (1m) (a) If the department establishes one or more open seasons for hunting deer with a rifle, shotgun, handgun, or muzzle-loading firearm, the department shall allow a person

who holds the appropriate license to hunt deer during that open season with a lesser weapon. A person allowed to hunt with a crossbow during an open season described under this paragraph is not required to hold a crossbow permit issued under s. 29.171 (4) (a) or a Class A, Class B, or Class C permit issued under s. 29.193 (2).

(b) If the department establishes an open season for hunting deer with a bow and not a firearm, then the department shall prohibit the use of a superior weapon during that open season except by a person who holds the appropriate license and to which any of the following applies:

1. The person has attained the age of 65.
2. The person is authorized to hunt with a crossbow by a crossbow permit issued under s. 29.171 (4) (a).
3. The person is authorized to hunt with a crossbow by Class A, Class B., or Class C permit issued under s. 29.193 (2).

SECTION 3. Wild Turkey Hunting Approval. 29.164 (2) (b) of the statutes, as affected by 2009 Wisconsin Act 119, is amended and recreated to read:

29.164 (2) (b) *Type of hunting authorized.* A license issued under this section authorizes hunting with any weapon.

SECTION 4. 29.173 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended and recreated to read:

29.173 (2) (a) A resident deer hunting license authorizes the hunting of deer with any weapon.

SECTION 5. 29.173 (2) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.173 (2) (b) (intro.) A qualified service member holding a current resident deer hunting license may hunt deer of either sex with any weapon during any season open to hunting of deer with firearms that is established by the department. For purposes of this paragraph, a qualified service member is a member of the armed forces who exhibits proof that he or she is in active service with the armed forces outside this state and proof of one of the following:

29.184 (3) (c) *Type of hunting authorized.* A Class A bear license authorizes hunting with any weapon.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) issues hunting licenses that authorize the hunting of specified animals such as deer, bear, and small game. ✓ Those licenses also specify the type of weapon that may be used for hunting under those licenses. For example, a deer hunting license authorizes the holder of the license to only hunt with a firearm but a Class A bear license authorizes the license holder to hunt with a firearm, a bow and arrow, and under certain circumstances a crossbow. DNR also establishes seasons during which the hunting of certain animals with a specified weapon is allowed. ✓ when

This bill expands the types of weapons that may be used under the authority of a deer, elk, wild turkey, small game, and Class A bear hunting license. ✓ Under the bill, each of these licenses authorizes a person to hunt with a firearm, a bow and arrow, or a crossbow. The bill eliminates the requirement that a person must be at least 65 years old or be disabled and hold a crossbow permit in order to hunt with a crossbow under the authority of any of these licenses. ✓ The bill does not change current law, which also allows the use of an airgun under the authority of a small game license. It also does not change current law under which a person who holds an archer hunting license may use a crossbow only if the person has attained the age of 65 or holds a ~~special~~ permit that authorizes the use of a crossbow. ✓

This bill also specifies that, when DNR opens a hunting season for the purpose of hunting deer, elk, wild turkey, small game, or bear with any firearm, DNR must

also allow the use of a bow and arrow and a crossbow during that open season by a person who holds the appropriate license.

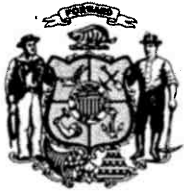

DNR also establishes seasons during which the hunting of certain animals with a specified weapon is allowed.

This bill expands the types of weapons that may be used under the authority of a deer, elk, wild turkey, small game, and Class A bear hunting license. Under the bill, each of these licenses authorizes a person to hunt with a firearm, a bow and arrow, or a crossbow. The bill eliminates the requirement that a person must be at least 65 years old or be disabled and hold a crossbow permit in order to hunt with a crossbow under the authority of any of these licenses. Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) issues hunting licenses that authorize the hunting of specified animals such as deer, bear, and small game. Those licenses also specify the type of weapon that may be used when hunting under those licenses. For example, a deer hunting license authorizes the holder of the license to only hunt with a firearm but a Class A bear license authorizes the license holder to hunt with a firearm, a bow and arrow, and under certain circumstances a crossbow. DNR also establishes seasons during which the hunting of certain animals with a specified weapon is allowed.

This bill expands the types of weapons that may be used under the authority of a deer, elk, wild turkey, small game, and Class A bear hunting license. Under the bill, each of these licenses authorizes a person to hunt with a firearm, a bow and arrow, or a crossbow. The bill eliminates the requirement that a person must be at least 65 years old or be disabled and hold a crossbow permit in order to hunt with a crossbow under the authority of any of these licenses. The bill does not change current law, which also allows the use of an airgun under the authority of a small

game license. It also does not change current law under which a person who holds an archer hunting license may use a crossbow only if the person has attained the age of 65 or holds a permit that authorizes the use of a crossbow.

This bill also specifies that, when DNR opens a hunting season for the purpose of hunting deer, elk, wild turkey, small game, or bear with any firearm, DNR must also allow the use of a bow and arrow and a crossbow during that open season by a person who holds the appropriate license. The bill further provides that, if DNR establishes an open season for hunting deer, elk, small game, wild turkey, or bear with a bow and arrow, but not with a firearm, then DNR may not open the season for hunting those animals with a crossbow. This prohibition does not apply under the bill to a person who is authorized under current law to use a crossbow based on age or disability.
