Regarding item 3, the change you want should apply to all districts, and not just the district for the Milwaukee area technical college, right?
Yes – thank you for clarifying.

Regarding item 1, I can accomplish your intent by allowing the people who are serving on the board, or who will have been appointed to the board, to continue to serve until their terms expire. This would work because 3 of the members have terms expiring on June 30, 21012, but I understand that 3 people are already lined up with appointments to replace them for terms beginning on July 1, 2012 that will expire on June 30, 2015. Another 3 have terms expiring on June 30, 2013, and the remaining 3 have terms expiring on June 30, 2014. So I could achieve your intent by allowing all of the foregoing to serve until June 30 in 2015, 2013, and 2014, respectively, with new members being appointed to replace them when the those terms expire. Is that okay?

Hi Mark -
Rep. Mason needs several additional amendments to SB 275, please.

1. A simple amendment that changes the terms of the board members to be staggered – same membership proposal as the bill, but have 3 be added/replaced the first year, 3 the second year, and 3 the third year.
2. A simple amendment that states that the bill will be null and void if it violates federal law or in any way threatens or puts in jeopardy any federal licenses held by MATC.
3. A simple amendment that changes the technical college district capital expenditure borrowing limits described in ss38.15(1) (below) from current law \$1.5m to \$2m for projects that capital expenditures that target high demand occupations. Make this increase in borrowing limit applicable only for 2012-13.

2 amendment 2, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 5, line 15: before "section 38.08 (1) (b) of the statutes" insert "section
4 38.08 (1) (a) 1g. of the statutes, as created by this act, and".

5 **2.** Page 5, line 19: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
6 page 6, line 20, and substitute:

7 "(am) Two of the members specified in section 38.08 (1) (a) 1g. a. of the statutes,
8 as created by this act, and one of the members specified in section 38.08 (1) (a) 1g.
9 d. of the statutes, as created by this act, shall have terms ending on June 30, 2016.
10 Of the members specified in section 38.08 (1) (a) 1g. a. of the statutes, as created by
11 this act, who are appointed under this paragraph, one member shall represent
