## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) from regulating sources that emit hazardous air contaminants associated with agricultural waste except to the extent required by federal law. DATCP is not directly impacted by postponing state rulemaking until federal requirements come into being. The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) does not have rulemaking authority in this area, and has agreed only to a limited role in supporting DNR in future rulemaking efforts.

However, DATCP may be affected by local government actions. Local governments may consider adopting livestock facility siting ordinances or other regulation to indirectly manage air emissions from livestock operations in the absence of state regulation. DATCP has oversight authority over local livestock regulation, such as livestock facility siting ordinances, to ensure conformity with state requirements. At this point, it is not possible to determine what specific actions will be pursued at the local level, and the extent to which DATCP will be required to perform oversight functions.
