Description

Preaccreditation and accreditation of private schools participating in the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program and the choice program for eligible school districts, certificates of occupancy for participating private school buildings, verification of income eligibility for pupils to participate in the programs, fees and tuition charged to pupils attending participating private schools, and standards of conduct for administrators of participating private schools

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill relates to the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program and the choice program for eligible school districts. No taxes are affected by the bill.

Under current law, the Department of Revenue is required to determine whether pupils are eligible to participate in these school choice programs on the basis of family income. This bill clarifies that the Department of Revenue does not make an eligibility determination, but simply verifies the pupils' eligibility based on family income.
