Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law indicates a school district may provide an instructional program in human growth and development and specifies that such a program, if offered, must provide medically relevant information and address certain topics. Current law also specifies what an instructional program must do, defines terminology, provides for pupil exemption and parental notification, requires the appointment of a district advisory committee, requires the state superintendent to apply for federal funds to implement an evidence-based teen pregnancy prevention program, and permits a volunteer health care provider to provide instructional programming.

AB 337 modifies the requirements of an instructional program in human growth and development and recommends, rather than requires, certain instructional topics. In addition, the bill modifies the definitions of certain terminology, clarifies pupil instruction exemptions, eliminates parental notification requirements in the absence of instructional programming, specifies the purpose and composition of the school district advisory committee, changes the type of federal funding for which the state superintendent is required to apply, and prevents a volunteer health care provider from providing instructional programming.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Department or local health departments.
