Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

BILL SUMMARY

This proposal will require DOT to post signs advising customers that they may be eligible for an identification card at no cost for the purposes of voting. The signs must be posted conspicuously in all DMV customer service centers.

ASSUMPTIONS

With the passage of 2011 Wisconsin Act 23, WisDOT created signage that notifies customers who come into a DMV service center that identification cards needed for voting purposes can be obtained at no cost by checking a special box on the application form.

Currently, signs are posted in every DMV service center, in English and Spanish.

CONCLUSIONS

DMV assumes the signage already displayed in the customer service centers is sufficient to meet the requirements of this proposal.

Using these assumptions, there should be no cost to DMV.
