Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill replaces "land surveying" with the term "practice of professional land surveying," and defines the term. The certificate of registration requirement is replaced with a licensure requirement, and the process to obtain it is defined. The bill provides additional requirements for professional land surveyors, and makes several changes to the laws relating to subdivision plats, certified survey maps, and the recording of certain plats.

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not envision a fiscal impact upon their offices because the bill does not appear to create any penalties for violation.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not anticipate a long-term fiscal effect if this bill is enacted.
