Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would allow the Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF) to require that a participant who is receiving duty disability under s. 40.65 of the Wisconsin Statutes be examined by at least one physician approved by ETF annually. The purpose of this examination is to verify whether or not the individual is still eligible for duty disability benefits.

It is anticipated that very few such examinations would be required by ETF. As such, it is anticipated that this bill will not have a material fiscal impact on either administrative costs or program costs.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
