## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill would allow local governments to appoint traffic attendants for specific events, subject to a training requirement. It is assumed that local entities would incur some cost associated with training such attendants, but actual costs would vary depending on the scope of the training and the number of attendants to be trained. This bill only creates the authority to appoint attendants; use of such attendants is not mandated.
