#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill, as amended, makes several changes to the process by which the Department issues permits to place a structure or deposit in, or withdraw water from, a navigable water or to conduct a certain activity in or near a navigable water.

As amended, the bill shortens some of the time limits under the public hearing and comment process for these types of permits. The 30-day time period for an interested party to request a public hearing or for DNR to make a decision on its own to hold a public hearing is shortened from 30 days to 15 days and the 30-day time period for the rendering a decision is shortened from 30 days to 20 days following the conclusion of the public comment period. If DNR fails to comply with the time limits relating to the public hearing and comment process, the application for the permit or contract shall be considered to have been approved; however, the Department may impose terms and conditions on the approval, provided that they are consistent with the applicant's basic proposal. In addition, in an administrative hearing related to this type of permitting, the petitioner has the burden of proof.

#### State Fiscal Effect

- 1. One-Time Implementation costs The bill is expected to result in increased workload related to updating program procedures and databases, revising application materials, training staff, and conducting customer outreach. Implementation is estimated to require estimated one-time expenditures of \$55,500 and an estimated 1,300 hours of staff time. The detailed one-time costs are as follows:
- a. 200 hours for updating internal procedures and application materials, conducting staff training and external outreach, by Policy Coordinator @ \$44.58/hr. salary & fringe =\$ 8,900 b. 160 hours for updating internal procedures and conducting staff training

by Database Manager @ \$44.58/hr. salary & fringe = \$7,100

- c. 40 hours for review, staff training and outreach, by Section Chief @ \$57.95/hr. salary & fringe = \$2,300
- d. 44 hours for review and staff training by Attorney @ \$74.29/hr. salary & fringe = \$3,300
- e. 40 hours for updating program database by Database Contractor @ \$68.00/hr. = \$2,700
- f. 24 hours for attending staff training by 35 field Water Regulation and Zoning Specialists @ \$37.14/hr. salary & fringe = \$31,200
- g. Total one-time costs: \$55,500
- 2. Presumptive Permitting The bill establishes that all individual permit applications where DNR does not meet deadlines are presumptively approved. At full staffing levels, it is assumed that the Department will meet all new or modified process deadlines.

The Department does anticipate some increase in permit appeals due to citizen, neighbor or stakeholder concerns about insufficient assessment of impacts or insufficient permit conditions due to shorter permit timelines. In the last 2 years DNR has received 7 permit appeals annually. It is difficult to predict how many more contested case hearing requests will be triggered by the bill; however, a typical hearing currently costs about \$11,200 based on the following assumptions:

- a. 80 hours of case preparation, presentation and briefs by Attorney @ \$74.29/hr. salary & fringe = \$5,900
- b. 8 hours of consultation and case preparation by Section Chief @ \$57.95/hr. salary & fringe = \$500
- c. 40 hours of consultation and case preparation by Policy Coordinator @ \$44.58/hr. salary & fringe = \$1,800
- d. 80 hours of case preparation and hearing testimony by field Water Regulation and Zoning Specialist @ \$37.14/hr. salary & fringe = \$3,000
- e. Total estimated cost per contested case hearing: \$11,200

### Private Sector Impact

As a result of the bill, the Department anticipates that it will develop a web-based public noticing system for permits, which will result in minor cost savings to permit applicants who will no longer need to pay for the cost of publishing a notice in a local newspaper.
