Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the possession, by a person who is incarcerated in a prison or who resides in a mental health facility, of a correctional employee's personal identifying information or a document relating to the employee's personal identifying information. A person who violates this prohibition is guilty of a Class H felony.
