### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The fiscal estimate assumes that the Department of Workforce Development would serve approximately 500 individuals per year in each of the three years of the pilot program. The fiscal estimate does not include the unknown costs associated with the provision which considers participants to be employees of the state for purposes of worker's compensation benefits.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The bill provides for a three-year pilot program, so there are no anticipated long-range fiscal implications.
