**Senate Substitute
Amendment 1**

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2011 Senate Bill 153

Senate Bill 153 requires the Group Insurance Board to offer each available health insurance plan to local government employers and their employees, even if the employer does not participate in the Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS).

Senate Substitute Amendment 1

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 maintains the requirement to offer each available health insurance plan whether or not the local governmental employer participates in the WRS, but updates the language and citation of the applicable statutory section to reflect revisions made by 2011 Wisconsin Act 32, the Biennial Budget Bill.

Legislative History

Senate Bill 153 was introduced on July 15, 2011, by Senator Wanggaard. Senate Substitute Amendment 1 was offered on October 5, 2011, by Senator Wanggaard. On October 13, 2011, the Senate Committee on Labor, Public Safety, and Urban Affairs adopted the substitute amendment on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.

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
