Current Law

Under current law, a campaign finance report must provide the occupation and name and address of the principal place of employment, if any, for each individual contributor whose cumulative contributions total more than \$100 for the calendar year.

Senate Bill 292

2011 Senate Bill 292 eliminates the requirement that a campaign finance report must include the name and address of a contributor's principal place of employment if the contributor's cumulative contributions total more than \$100 in a calendar year, but maintains the requirement to include the contributor's occupation.

Senate Amendment 3

Senate Amendment 3 retains the requirement from current law that a campaign finance report must include a contributor's occupation and principal place of employment, but increases the threshold amount at which this information must be provided. Under the amendment, a campaign finance report must contain the occupation and name and address of the principal place of employment, if any, of each individual contributor whose cumulative contributions total more than ***\$250 for the calendar year.***

Legislative History

Senate Amendment 3 was offered by Senator Lazich on January 20, 2012. The Senate Committee on Transportation and Elections adopted the amendment on January 23, 2012, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2. The committee then recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
